### ***Sielox™ Introduces Pinnacle™ Access Control v5.0.***

*New Version Features Automatic Disconnect Notification And Automatic Reconnect.*

Las Vegas, NV (April 5, 2006) – The newly formed Sielox™, formerly Checkpoint Systems, Inc. Access Control Products Group, has upgraded the capabilities of its highly acclaimed Pinnacle™ access control software solution in its new version 5.0.

Pinnacle™ v5.0 new features include an automatic reconnect feature when a network connection has been lost, without the necessity of having the client logged in as an administrator. Upon a connection disruption, a Network Status message, along with an audible signal, is initiated at each appropriate workstation. When LAN communications are restored, the Network Status message is updated with a reconnect button enabled. Additional upgrades incorporated into Pinnacle™ v5.0 include an e-mail report scheduler, alarm notification on start-up, a parity check configuration option for error

detection, drag and drop of Main Controllers across hardware servers allowing hardware servers to be easily added to an existing configuration, and additional content in the Help-About screen.

Pinnacle™ v5.0 also offers 40% improvement in User Action screen performance for direct control of security devices and 50X data processing performance in managing transactions and alarms for use of device groups as related to SQL database queries. Also, card lists are now filtered by controller during a refresh, enhancing the speed at which new cardholder and device data is sent to the intelligent Sielox™ controller. Finally, support has been added for alarm escalation notification in Device Setup Tree, further highlighting the most important alarm events.

An upcoming version of Pinnacle™ (version 6.0) available for previewing at ISCW offers a new mapping feature, native to Pinnacle's™ code as a licensed option. Fully featured with design and view modes, icons can be placed for device status or activated for user action (i.e. door lock/unlock, output on/off, etc.). In the design mode, AutoCad DXF and DWG based floor plans can be easily imported. Further enhancing the product's overall system control, maps can be integrated with Pinnacle's™ user permissions and database schemes or "shared" in database partitioning.
